Award Name	Criteria
Student of the Year Award	Awarded to a student considering his/ her excellence in academic studies, sportsmanship, interest in aesthetic and cultural activities, proven leadership among peers, exemplary conduct and character.
D.P.P. Samarasekera Peace Prize	Awarded to the student who shows marked interest either within the University Community or outside it in activities which Foster social harmony and/or shows courtesy, consideration, kindness and understanding in assisting those in distress
Canekeratne Prize for General Merit	Awarded to a student who graduates with a First or Second Class (Upper Division) Pass in the special degree examination and has considerable achievement in extracurricular activities.
Prof. Tilak Hettiarachchy Award for Academic Excellence	Awarded to an undergraduate who secured a First class in the special or general degree programme of any Faculty in the University of Colombo by considering publications and research carried out during his/ her undergraduate career, prizes and medals won, Scholarships/ Studentships obtained at the year 1 examinations, any other endowed Scholarships/ Bursaries including commonwealth elective bursary obtained for academic

Name of the Award	Criteria
Faculty Award for Best Performing Students	<p>Faculty Award for Best Performing Students is awarded annually to the overall best performing students in each batch based on their achievements in the academic and extracurricular activities of the year under consideration.</p> <p>Eligibility Requirements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Should be undergraduate students registered to follow any internal undergraduate degree programme at UCSC. ● Should have obtained grades of C or above for all the academic courses and completed all the enhancement courses, registered during the year under consideration. ● Should have obtained a Class GPA of 3.30 or above in each semester of the year under consideration. ● Should have displayed outstanding performance in the extra-curricular activities during the year under consideration. ● Should have obtained as a minimum of 70% of the total marks for the below mentioned marks for the application by totaling the marks earned from the academic achievements and extracurricular activities during the year under consideration. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ <i>Academic Achievements (60%): A weight of 60% will be assigned for academic achievements during the year under consideration.</i> <i>[Marks for academic achievement = (Class GPA of the year under consideration /4.00)*60]</i> ○ <i>Extra-curricular Activities (40%): A weight of 40% will be assigned for extra-curricular activities. Only activities conducted during the year under consideration should be taken into account when claiming marks under this category.</i> <i>[Marks for extra-curricular activities = (Obtained Marks / 100) * 40]</i> ● Students who are absent for any registered course/courses for whatever reason during the year under consideration will not be eligible to apply for the award. ● Students on whom disciplinary action has been taken and/or

	warned (in writing) by the ViceChancellor or Director of UCSC for any misconduct shall not be eligible.
The Director's List	<p>An internal undergraduate student registered to pursue any degree programme offered by the UCSC shall be included to the Director's list each semester, if the student achieves a GPA equal to or more than 3.70 [Class GPA].</p> <p>Eligibility Requirements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Should be an internal undergraduate registered to follow any degree programme offered by the UCSC. ● Should have obtained grades of C or above for all the academic courses and completed all the enhancement courses, registered during the semester under consideration. ● Should have obtained a GPA of 3.70 or above during the semester under consideration. ● Students who are absent for any registered course/courses for whatever reason during the year under consideration will not be eligible to apply for the award. ● Students on whom disciplinary action has been taken and/or warned (in writing) by the ViceChancellor or Director of UCSC for any misconduct shall not be eligible.
